

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Pollution Monitors Ltd recognizes as a primary responsibility the need to work towards a policy of a sustainable environment. Much of our work is to help others reduce airborne gaseous emissions by providing appropriate monitoring equipment.

As a company we are minimal users of energy, well under the Climate Change Levy limits, however, we conserve energy wherever possible. As a policy we re-use packing materials, place waste paper and card in a designated on-site skip for recycling, sort all waste returned to our workshops with electronic and electrical components collected for disposal under the WEEE Directive and batteries and gas sensors cells sorted and disposed of under the Battery Directive.

The use of chemicals and water are incidental to our business and do not cause an environmental hazard. Our service business requires visits to customer sites. We use public transport when practical. The company is registered under the Waste Regulations 2011 as a carrier of its own waste
